# Pastor's Thoughts to Ponder

#### Daniel 1:2, "The Lord Gave"

For myself and many others, I think when we see these three words, "the Lord gave", our minds rush to John 3:16. There He gave His Son as an offering for our sin. Because of that, as believers, we are the children of God and have received eternal life through Jesus Christ.

As parents and grandparents, we too love to give things to our family that we know they need or even might like to have. Christmas, birthdays, anniversaries, and on and on we look for the opportunity to show our love through giving. But sometimes we also must give what we don't want to give. A child may be given a spanking for some act that he or she did. A teenager may be disciplined by losing their privilege to drive or to use their phone. An adult may be given a sentence in jail or prison for some crime they committed. The list could go on and on.

In our text, God is said to have given something to the southern tribe of Judah. You would think it would have been a wonderful gift, but instead, a needful act. God gave his covenant people over to the King of Babylon! God gave the Gentile nation the power and ability to throw down the walls and also the temple, and allowed them to take the holy furnishings from the temple at Jerusalem and carry them away and place them in a temple of false gods at Shinar! God, because of the way the people chose to live and the things they were doing, had to give what today would be considered, "tough love".

If God were to give us something today, would it be the kind of gifts that we would be thankful for and share with others, or would it be things to correct us and to get us to look in His direction?

We often make the choice in what we receive from God.
